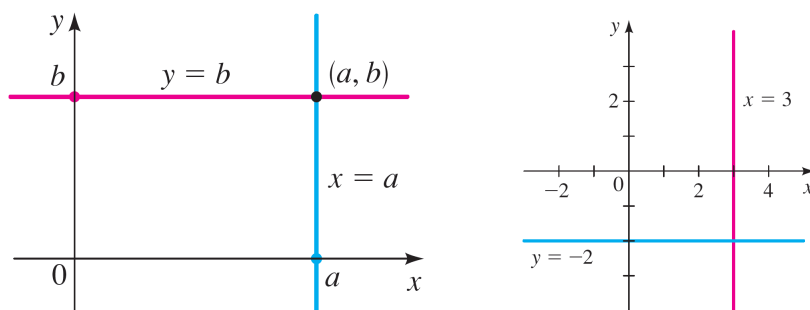


Vertical and Horizontal Lines



EXAMPLE:

- (a) The graph of the equation $x = 3$ is a vertical line with x -intercept 3 .
- (b) The graph of the equation $y = -2$ is a horizontal line with y -intercept -2 .
